Information for authors

Acta Universitatis Sapientiae, Communicatio is a peer-reviewed scientific journal published yearly. It aimes at publishing theoretical and empirical research in communication studies, with a focus on information society issues. The journal is interested in all the variety of academic traditions in the field and promotes dialogue between them. Communicatio invites academic researchers and other professionals of communication and media to disseminate new and original works. It publishes genuine, previously unpublished research: surveys, case studies, reports, and reviews on both applied and theoretical aspects of communication issues.

All submitted manuscripts are reviewed by two anonymous referees. Papers should be submitted in English, in A4 format, electronically (in .doc, .docx, or .rtf format) to the e-mail address of the journal: acta-comm@acta.sapientia.ro.

Manuscripts should conform to the following guidelines:

Articles should range from 4,000 to 10,000 words, including footnotes and references. Reviews and research notes should not exceed 4,000 words. All manuscripts should be accompanied by a 200–250-word abstract with 3–5 keywords and with authors' affiliation. Tables and graphs, if any, should be prepared in black and white, titled, numbered, and integrated in the main text. References should follow the author-date system of the APA Manual of Style (https://www.citethisforme.com/guides/apa). The list of references should appear at the end of the manuscripts.

Acta Universitatis Sapientiae, Communicatio is published once a year in November.
