Acta Universitatis Sapientiae, Social Analysis publishes empirical and theoretical studies, research notes and commentaries, surveys, case studies, reports, as well as book and conference reviews in the fields of communication, social and regional sciences.

The focus of the journal is primarily oriented towards East-Central Europe and its regions. Empirical findings, policy analysis, and critical essays aimed at describing the processes of social development, cultural reconfiguration, information society and associated discourses taking place in this part of Europe are particularly welcome.

Acta Universitatis Sapientiae, Social Analysis is a peer-reviewed scientific journal published yearly. All submitted manuscripts are reviewed by two anonymous referees. Contributors are expected to submit genuine, previously unpublished research, original manuscripts that reflect the results of their personal scientific work. Manuscripts sent to the journal should not have been previously published and should not be considered for publication by other journals.

Individual articles appear in the 'online first' system after closing the editorial process, while full issues of Social Analysis containing the collected articles are published yearly, in November.
