

Tutoring Programme in 2015 – At the Department of European Studies

The Department announced its first tutoring programme in 2011, when six MA students began the research activity under the teachers' professional and educational supervision. The first announcement already showed that the weaknesses of the programme consist in maintaining and stabilizing the enrolled students. Therefore, in the subsequent years, we introduced new elements of co-operation with the students, and the programme became more stable.

In the academic year 2015/16, the fifth year in the programme's history, students' interest turned out to be bigger than before: 11 MA and 2 BA students were enrolled in the talent-supporting programme. Among the chosen research topics, there are both classical, e.g. civil society, and actual ones, e.g. migration.

The programme started on November 28, 2015, and the students expressed their wish to visit political and scientific institutions in Bucharest.
